

Funding Ranges for Local Health Departments: Sub-Granting Expectations

Sub-granting is expected as funding levels increase. Sub-grantees are chosen based on their ability to complete the SOW objectives working with school based organizations (SBOs), community based organizations (CBOs), and local cities with a high proportion of low-income Californians.

\$200,000 or less

\$200,001-\$299,999

Expected to sub-grant 15 to 25 percent of funds to sub-grantees

Estimated sub-grantee minimum amounts: \$52,000-75,000

\$300,000-\$399,999

Expected to sub-grant 20 to 30 percent of funds to sub-grantees

Estimated sub-grantee minimum amounts: \$75,001-170,999

\$400,000-\$599,999

Expected to sub-grant 30 to 40 percent of funds to sub-grantees

Estimated sub-grantee minimum amounts: \$171,000-\$233,000

\$600,000-\$999,999

Expected to sub-grant 30 to 50 percent of funds to sub-grantees

Estimated sub-grantee minimum amounts: \$327,000-\$467,000

\$1,000,000-\$1,599,999

Expected to sub-grant 30 to 50 percent of funds to sub-grantees

Estimated sub-grantee minimum amounts: \$550,000-\$698,000

\$1,600,000-\$2,999,999

Expected to sub-grant 30 to 50 percent of funds to sub-grantees

Estimated sub-grantee minimum amounts: \$884,000-\$1,200,000

\$3,000,000 or greater

Expected to sub-grant 30-50 percent of funds to sub-grantees

Estimated sub-grantee minimum amounts: \$1,800,000-\$8,000,000
