CX3 Orientation Webinar

This introductory webinar for local health departments explains the importance of examining the food and physical activity environment in low-income neighborhoods. It provides background on the development of CX³ and rationale for implementation. Presenters cover the design of the project, a conceptual flow and basic steps of the process, and teach LHDs how to select CX3 neighborhoods. CX3 GIS Mapping Training

CX³ participants use an on-line GIS map viewer to complete a series of CX³ instruments/worksheets (supermarket access, transit to supermarkets, farmers' markets, fast food outlets, and markets around schools) to compile and interpret mapping data. This skill-building training is hands-on with lots of practice time. The training is intended for LHDs beginning the CX3 process in FY14. Other LHDs who have already completed GIS Mapping (aka: Tier 1) but would like a refresher or train new staff are welcome to attend, space permitting.
