The FFY14 Activity Tracking Form (ATF) is a required document for all contractors conducting nutrition education or related activities. Activities or events that need to be tracked include but are not limited to nutrition education, stakeholder meetings, material distribution, trainings, etc. the FFY14 ATF has been extensively modified from the FFY13 ATF including transitioning to an online system. **Every person that needs access to the new online ATF will need to complete a training before receiving a username and password.** More information will be provided when the training dates are finalized.
