Analysis Reports: How to Score Using your Data to Prevent Infections!

- Generate a NHSN analysis report by date and location
- Export NHSN analysis data to other programs (i.e. Access, Excel) for enhanced reporting capabilities
- Demonstrate a variety of ways to present data: spreadsheets, graphs, pie charts etc.
