### “Using Data Validation for Improved HAI Surveillance and Prevention”

**Course Description:**

Using what was learned during the 2011 HAI data validation reviews in 100 California hospitals, the HAI Liaison Program will provide a three-hour course on performing quality surveillance for HAI, which will be repeated in 18 locations throughout the state from May to July 2012. The intended audience includes hospital leaders overseeing infection prevention programs, infection preventionists (IPs), quality improvement directors and staff, and others focused on ensuring data are complete, accurate, and valid for assessing ongoing HAI prevention efforts.

**Objectives:**

Use the 2011 HAI Liaison Program data validation findings to improve HAI surveillance; specifically

1. Identify best practices for case-finding;
2. Review NHSN protocols, focusing on areas where interpretation is problematic;
3. Demonstrate how a standalone hospital or hospital group can use the process and forms for internal data validation efforts; and
4. Use case scenarios to practice the application of consistent, standardized surveillance necessary for HAI prevention.
