- ◆ Describe the key elements of the life course perspective and how it explains the impact of biological, behavioral, psychological, and social factors on maternal, child, and adolescent health and wellness paths; as well as their role in supporting an optimal life course trajectory.
- ◆ Identify risk factors present during pregnancy, delivery, or postpartum with the greatest odds of increasing length of hospital stay and discuss strategies to achieve risk-appropriate maternal care that optimize pregnancy and birth outcomes.
