

## Infant CVV Food Package Practice Scenarios

Working with a partner, use the *Options for Baby* flyers and the flow charts to practice what you will do and how you will ask if the parent or caregiver is interested in the new Infant CVV Food Package. After each scenario, alternate roles with your partner.

Possible wording that you might use for the Infant CVV Food Package question:

*When your baby is 9 months old, would you like to continue receiving the 6-11 months infant food package that provides all jarred infant fruits and vegetables, or would you like a combo package that includes **fewer** jarred infant fruits and vegetables and adds **fresh** fruits and vegetables?*

### Scenario 1:

The infant is 6 months old, in the clinic for SM appointment, and is ready for solid foods. The parent wants to receive the new Infant CVV Food Package when her infant is 9 months.

### Scenario 2:

The infant is 7 months old, in the clinic for SM appointment, and is ready for solid foods. The parent does not know if she will want the new Infant CVV Food Package when her daughter is 9 months.

### Scenario 3:

The infant is 8 months old, had attended an SM appointment when he was 5 months old. At the SM appointment, the parent received the required Education and chose to receive the new Infant CVV Food Package when her son turns 9 months old.

### Scenario 4:

The infant is 10 months old, has not attended an SM appointment, and the caregiver did not receive the required education but does want to receive the new Infant CVV Food package.
