



WIC MIS CHANGE RELEASE NOTICE For Local Agencies

Purpose The Change Release Notice provides updated information to CDPH WIC and all WIC Local Agency staff about new features, enhancements to existing features, and defects fixed that are now available in production.

The table below indicates the WIC MIS system schedule for a Change Release that was deployed to production, including the effective date.

Fixes

This section is used to describe fixes to existing features that were the result of a defect.

1. The wrong food package items printed for infants who were transitioning from their 5th month to their 6th month.

PROBLEM:	When FIs for an infant 5 months old were triple-issued, the Rx transitioned correctly to their 6 th month; however, the CVV food items printed instead of the all-jarred infant fruits and vegetables.
RESOLUTION:	The incorrect food items will no longer print.

2. When an Infant transitioned to a Child or when a Child transitioned to 24 months of age, some food packages were not transitioning correctly to their corresponding food packages. For example, if a child > 24 months of age was receiving a CT4L package, when the child turned 24 months old, the package was reverting to the default package CP4 instead of CP4L.

PROBLEM:	When an Infant transitioned to Child, or when a Child transitioned to 24 months of age, some food packages were not transitioning correctly to the corresponding package for an older child.
RESOLUTION:	When an Infant transitions to Child, or when a Child transitions to 24 months of age, the food packages now correctly transition. For example, CT4L will transition to CP4L at 24 months of age rather than reverting to the default package CP4.

- There was a wrong cursor placement in the “Prescribe Food Package” screen when an incorrect “Prescription Good Through” date was entered and F11 pressed.

PROBLEM:	If the infant feeding choice is Z and an incorrect “Prescription Good Through” date entered, when F11 is pressed, the error message was properly displayed; however, the cursor incorrectly went to Question 1 instead of the “Prescription Good Through” field.
RESOLUTION:	When an incorrect “Prescription Good Through” date is entered and F11 is pressed, the cursor will now correctly land on the “Prescription Good Through” field instead of Question 1.

Enhancements

This section is used to describe changes to existing features that were not a result of a defect.

- Five (5) new preferred languages have been added to WIC MIS and Autodialer.

PROBLEM:	WIC is serving an increased number of participants that speak Central/South American indigenous languages and the Indian/Sri Lankan language. These languages were not available in WIC MIS.
RESOLUTION:	<p>The following languages have been added to WIC MIS in order to allow for more flexible appointment schedule creation and the ability to more appropriately schedule a family's appointment in their preferred language. These new preferred languages have also been added to the WIX-Autodialer.</p> <p>MA – Mam MY – Maya MT – Mixteca QU – Quechua TM – Tamil</p>
