10/10/08	JFC International, Inc. is recalling all Kyosai Sengiri Daikon (40/3.50z) due to the presence of undeclared sulfites. The recall was initiated after routine sampling and lab analysis by Florida State Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Division of Food Safety revealed the presence of sulfites which were not declared on the label.	JFC International, Inc., Los Angeles, California.	The dried radish product is being recalled due to the presence of undeclared sulfites. People who have an allergy or severe sensitivity to sulfite run the risk of life-threatening allergic reaction if they consume this product.
