### California Department of Public Health Warns Consumers not to eat Ticorindo Candy Imported From Mexico

Recall Date	Product Description	Firm	Recall Reason
12/31/09	Ticorindo Candy imported from Mexico. Recent analysis of this candy by CDPH determined that Ticorindo candy contained as much as 0.14 parts per million (ppm) of lead.	Manufactured by Pabsa in Mexico and distributed by Vernon Sales in Vernon, CA	California considers candies with lead levels in excess of 0.10 ppm to be contaminated.

N/A	Ticorindo candy is packaged in clear plastic with the word TICORINDO in bright red and yellow letters. The package also has three characters at the bottom which resemble a strawberry, pineapple and tamarind, each with large white eyes and red shoes. The top of the package is red and yellow and has a picture of a bird and a parrot. The package contains 10 pieces of candy each, wrapped in packaging that resembles the main package.
