



**California Medical Waste Management Program
MEDICAL WASTE TRANSPORTER
CHECKLIST**

This checklist is provided to help with your verification process. Keep for your records.

This Medical Waste Transporter Checklist was developed to assist transporters hauling medical waste in California with registration and maintaining current list status. Refer to the Medical Waste Management Act (MWMA) to ensure that all necessary submissions and protocols are completed.

- Per CA Health and Safety Code (HSC) Sections 118025 and 118029, all transporters hauling medical waste are required to be registered hazardous waste haulers. Obtain your Hazardous Waste Transporter Registration via the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC): <http://www.dtsc.ca.gov/HazardousWaste/index.cfm>
- Complete the Transporter Verification Form (CDPH 8666) available at: <http://www.cdph.ca.gov/pubsforms/forms/CtrldForms/cdph8668.pdf>.
- Attach a copy of your service agreement(s) with each transfer station and/or offsite treatment facility utilized.
- Attach a sample of the medical waste tracking document you will be using. Tracking Document information requirements are listed in HSC Section 118040.

Send the completed Annual Verification Form CDPH8668 along with attached copies of the DTSC Hazardous Waste Transporter Registration, service agreements and tracking document to:

Upon verification of requested documents the Department will place your name on the list of current transporters.

Once you begin transporting medical waste the Department requires you to:

- Submit quarterly reports of all medical waste generators that you service within 10 days after the end of each calendar quarter (HSC Section 118029). See CDPH Form 8666 for data submission protocols. <http://www.cdph.ca.gov/certlic/medicalwaste/Pages/Transporters.aspx>
- Annually renew your registration with DTSC and Verification Form CDPH8668 and attach requested documents with the Department.

Be advised that there may be additional requirements with other Agencies.
