**NOTICE OF PUBLIC AVAILABILITY OF CHANGES TO
PROPOSED REGULATIONS REGARDING
Title 22,
DPH-05-010, Scope of Practice in Licensed Health Facilities**

Pursuant to Government Code Section 11346.8(c), notice is hereby given that the Department has changed the text of the proposed regulations regarding Scope of Practice in Licensed Health Facilities (DPH 05-010) and is making the changed text available for public comment prior to adoption, amendment or repeal of the resulting regulations.
