#### Things to do before giving this tailgate training


- ▶ Be ready to discuss where guardrails, covers, screens, and fall restraint/fall arrest systems are used or should be used on the jobsite where there are skylights, roof or floor openings.
- Review Key Training Points on the back of card 1a (different areas can be covered at several tailgates).
- Look up *guardrails, floor, roof, screen,* and *fall protection* in the index and read the pages in the Cal/OSHA Pocket Guide for the Construction Industry (http://www.dir.ca.gov/dosh/dosh\_publications/ConstGuideOnline.pdf).
- Download a copy of the video *Preventing Falls through Skylights* (see download instructions: http://www.cdph.ca.gov/programs/ohb-face/Pages/SkylightAction.aspx) onto a DVD or flash drive or view the video on YouTube: http://dld.bz/c2bjp.

- ▶ Be prepared to discuss what happened in the video and your company's practices for preventing falls when working around skylights, roof or floor openings.




