DANGER Clothing and equipment contaminated with lead.

May damage fertility or the unborn child. Causes damage to the central nervous system.

- Do not eat, drink or smoke when handling.
- Do not remove dust by blowing or shaking.
- Dispose of lead contaminated wash water in accordance with applicable local, state, or federal regulations.
