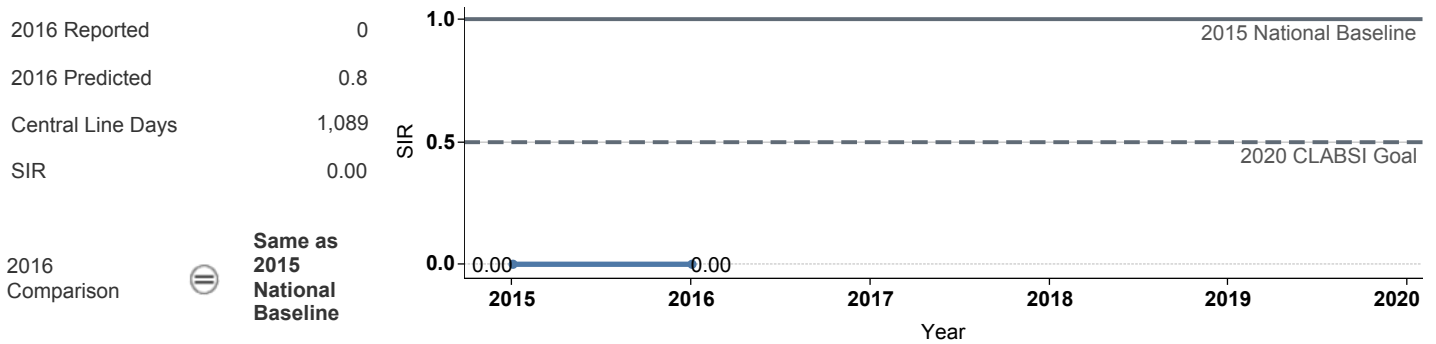

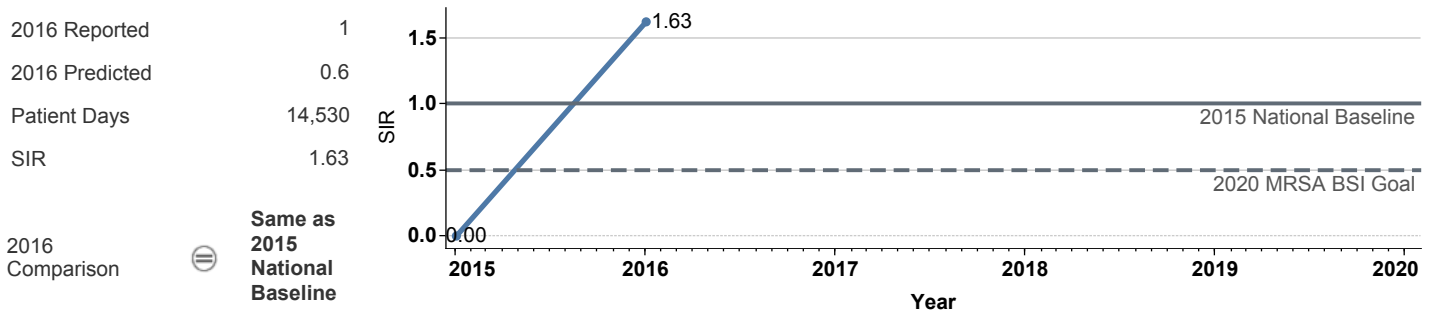

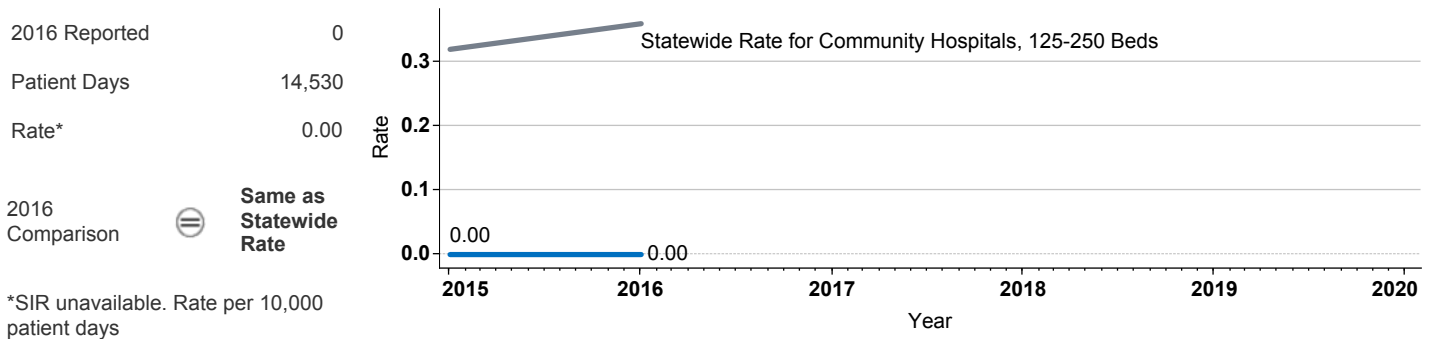
Central Line Associated Bloodstream Infection (CLABSI)



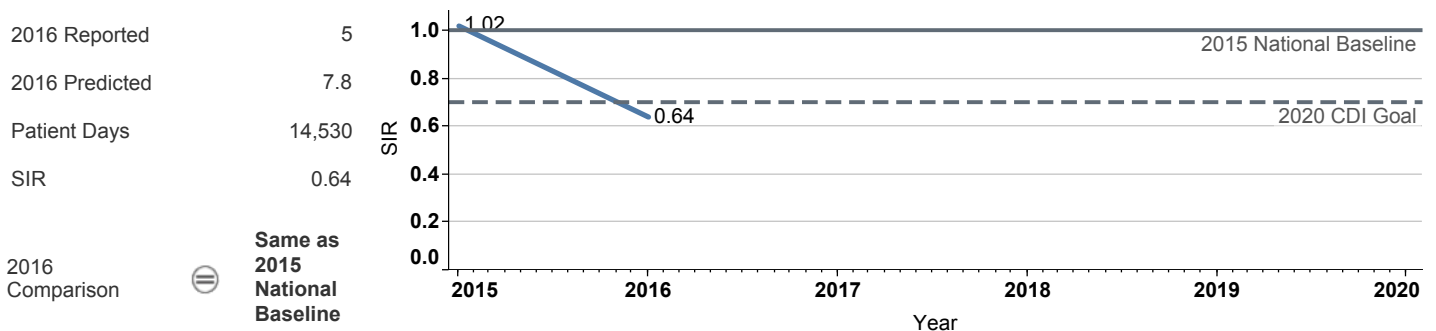
Methicillin-Resistant *Staphylococcus aureus* Bloodstream Infection (MRSA BSI)
