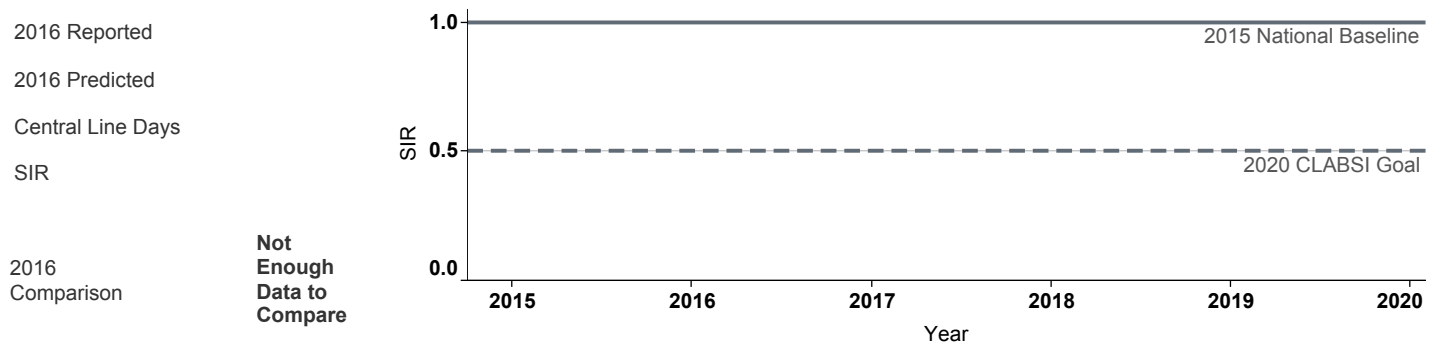

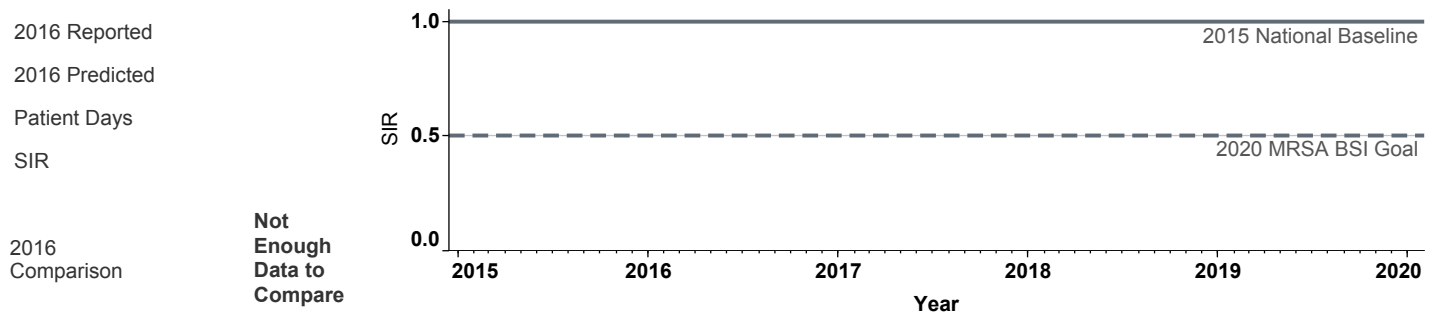

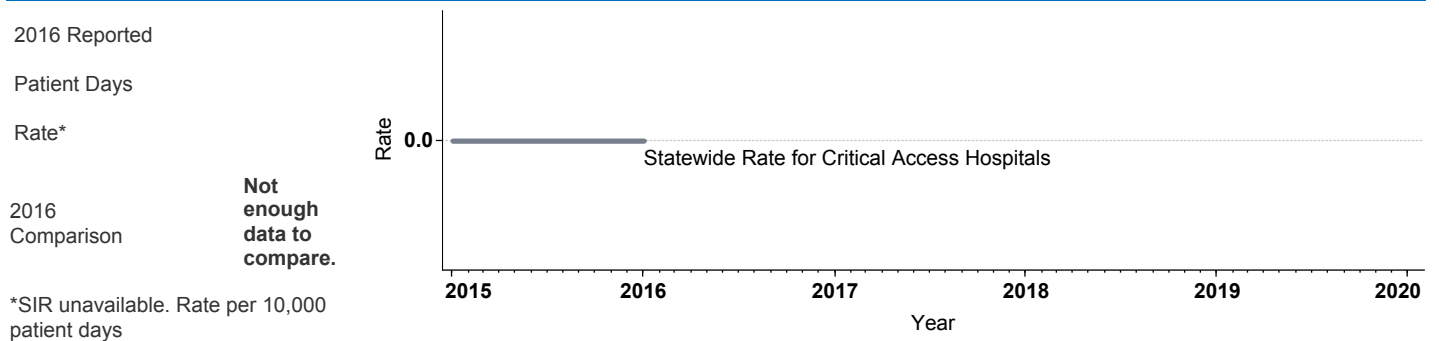
Central Line Associated Bloodstream Infection (CLABSI)



Methicillin-Resistant *Staphylococcus aureus* Bloodstream Infection (MRSA BSI)

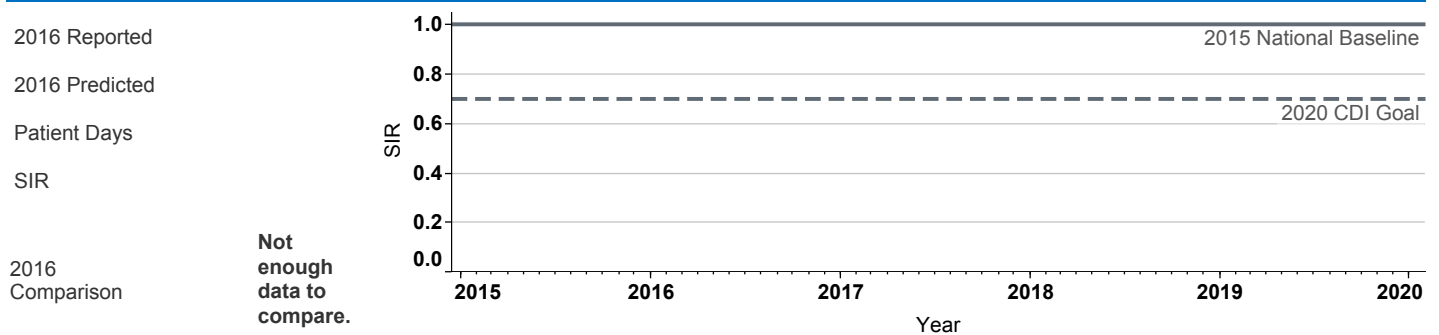


Vancomycin-Resistant *Enterococcus* Bloodstream Infection (VRE BSI)
