





CDPH Responsible Person

Create an Account

- You will need to create an account in order to access RSS
- Select the Create Now feature on the "CDPH has invited you to create an account" email you received



Create your own unique password



- Once you have created your unique password you will be automatically logged into RSS
- If someone else at your facility needs to have access to the surveys, please contact your CDPH District Office to have a "Create Account" invitation sent directly to them





Locate the Investigation or Survey from CDPH

- Login to https://hc.riskandsafety.com/ using your credentials
- Select the link to the report in the noti ication you received
 or
- Select the report from the **Action Items** section on the Platform Homepage

No Deficiency - Return Signed CMS 2567

- Please note that all Plans of Correction (POC) for investigations and surveys done in RSS should be submitted to CDPH electronically through RSS, rather than through the APC system
- The People tab "Responsible People" section provides the list of persons at the facility who have access to the investigation and can submit the signed CMS 2567
- Select the **Details** tab to review the cover letter and download a copy of the CMS 2567, which you will need to sign and upload in the next step. This will send the signed CMS 2567 back to CDPH electronically, without the need to mail or email it.
- The Incidents tab will contain a single question titled "Survey Records"
 - Select the "Survey Records" question
 - Select the blue Resolve button
 - Select the paper clip icon to attach the signed copy of the CMS 2567
 - ∘ Select Save
- This process electronically sends the signed CMS 2567 to CDPH through RSS instantly.

Provide a Plan of Correction for Findings

- Please note that all Plans of Correction (PoC) for investigations and surveys done in RSS should be submitted to CDPH electronically through RSS, rather than through the APC system
- Select the **Details** tab to review the cover letter and download a copy of the CMS 2567, which you will need to sign and upload in the next step. This will send the signed CMS 2567 back to CDPH electronically, without the need to mail or email it.
- The **People** tab "Responsible People" section provides the list of persons at the facility who have access to the investigation and can submit Plans of Correction for deficiencies





- The Incidents tab lists deficiencies identified that require the submission of a Plan of Correction
- To enter a Plan of Correction:
 - Select the deficiency
 - Select the blue Resolve button
 - Select the paper clip icon to attach the signed copy of the 2567 with Plan of Correction
 - In addition, copy and paste the Plan of Correction into the text field. Please enter the Plan of Correction in the "Comments" field only if it is ready to be sent, not a draft in progress, as clicking "Save" will send the Plan of Correction to CDPH
 - Select Save
 - o If there are multiple deficiencies, repeat the steps above for each deficiency
 - o This process electronically sends the PoC(s) to CDPH through RSS instantly

CDPH Review of Plans of Correction

- If CDPH accepts all POCs for the investigation, facility staff listed on the **People**tab in the "Responsible People" section will receive a notification indicating the
 investigation is complete
- If CDPH does not accept the POC for any deficiencies listed, facility staff listed on the **People** tab in the "Responsible People" section will receive a notification with further instructions for resubmitting the POC
- To enter a revised Plan of Correction:
 - Select the link in the notification to open the report
 - Select the Incidents tab
 - Select the deficiency
 - Select the blue Resolve button
 - o Enter the revised Plan of Correction
 - ∘ Select **Save**
- If there are multiple deficiencies that require submission of a revised POC, repeat the steps above for each deficiency
 - This process sends the POC(s) to CDPH via RSS instantly
- If no deficiencies were found, you must still submit a signed 2567 within 10 days. This can be done in the **Incidents** tab following the instructions above.
