NOTICE OF SECOND 15-DAY PUBLIC AVAILABILITY OF CHANGES TO PROPOSED REGULATIONS REGARDING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE USE OF X-RAY IN MAMMOGRAPHY (DPH-10-005)

PUBLIC PROCEEDINGS: Pursuant to Government Code section 11347.1, notice is hereby given that the California Department of Public Health (Department) has changed the text of the proposed regulations and added a document regarding Requirements for the Use of X-Ray in Mammography, (DPH-10-005).
